

Seven Days of Prayer for Ukraine

The situation in Ukraine seems to worsen daily. The government has been overturned, Crimea seems to be lost and now violence has been sparked in some Eastern Ukrainian cities. Despite their efforts, politicians have not yet been able to turn the situation around and stabilize what remains of Ukraine.

As a team of ABWE missionaries who have been working with local churches in Ukraine for over 20 years, we are deeply concerned with the current events in Ukraine. However, we know that even when politicians fail God is still able and God is still at work!

That is why we are calling on Christians everywhere to pray for Ukraine! We want to offer you seven ways to pray for Ukraine, one prayer request for each day of the week.

We encourage you to pray daily for Ukraine and to use the information below as a guide. Please also consider sharing these prayer requests with your church.

Sunday: Pray for church leaders that they would take every opportunity to proclaim the peace that Jesus offers and that they would not be limited in their freedoms to preach the gospel.

Monday: Pray for the new government in Kyiv that they would have wisdom to know how deal a failing economy and with groups who oppose them in Eastern Ukraine.

Tuesday: Pray for churches, especially in Eastern Ukraine, that they would exhibit the love of Christ be an example of how Russians and Ukrainians can coexist!

Wednesday: Pray for the Ukrainian people that there would be reconciliation and forgiveness between pro-Russian and pro-Ukrainian groups.

Thursday: Pray for families as they struggle to provide for basic needs because of a failing economy and high inflation.

Friday: Pray for Ukrainian soldiers, as many have family and friends in Eastern Ukraine and Russia. Pray that there would be no bloodshed.

Saturday: Pray for missionaries that God would give them wisdom to know how to help most effectively their brothers and sisters in Christ during this critical time.
